ITEM 5. SPECIAL COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. GOVERNMENT LIAISON - MCGANN DID NOT REPORT, BUT SEVERAL DIRECTORS MADE COMMENTS. ALL WERE DISTRESSED BY THE LACK OF LEADERSHIP AND CONCERN IN COAST GUARD HEAD-QUARTERS RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF THE LORAN CHAINS. THE EMPHASIS APPEARS TO BE ON FACILITATING THE CONVERSION TO GPS AT SOME TIME IN THE FUTURE, DISREGARDING THE PROBLEMS AND OPPORTUNITIES OF THE EXISTING LORAN CHAINS. THE RE-STRUCTURING OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC CHAINS WAS DISCUSSED. AMBROSENO POINTED OUT THAT THE TWO-STEP METHOD ADOPTED BY THE COAST GUARD PRESENTED A MAJOR PROBLEM TO ANYONE WHO HAD THE CHAINS STORED IN PROMS, REQUIRING TWO PROM CHANGES.

ITEM & NEW BUSINESS

- A. LAPEL PINS. THE SUPPLY OF WGA PINS WAS BROUGHT UP. DEAN RECALLED THAT A FEW WERE STILL IN EXISTENCE AND PROMISED TO SEARCH FOR THEM.
