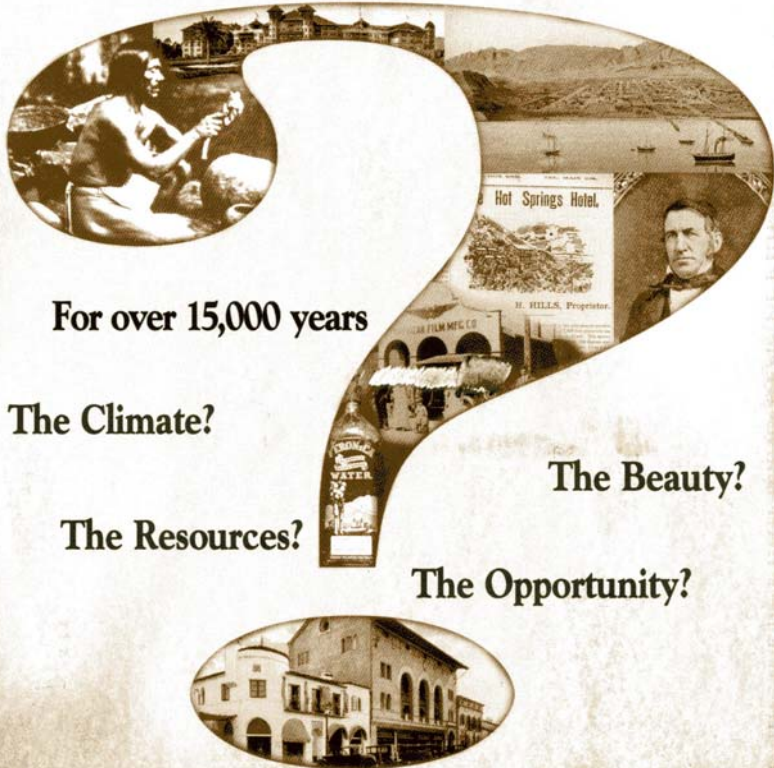

His love for Santa Barbara history began at age 13 when he worked for Mrs. Leontine Phelan, a descendant of the founder of the Santa Barbara Presidio.

No stranger to the stage or the press, he has given more than 250 presentations and written extensively on local and regional history in publications of the Santa Barbara Historical Society, the Trust for Historic Preservation and the Genealogical Society. Television credits include Emmy-Award-winner *Impressions in Time* and *This Old House*.
